## IT'S EASY TO BUILD YOUR OWN ARRAY STATION



- 1. Use the supplied foldable dishes or download and print them from www.ska.gov.au
- 2. Colour each dish to give them personalised flair!

  Cut them out and fold them using the instructions provided.
- **3.** Attach paddle-pop sticks to the bottom of your dishes with tape and stick them in the ground.
- **4.** If you've got anywhere from 10 to 1000 dishes then you have yourself your very own SKA Virtual Array station!
